


Park of Palms Map

Teddy Bear Palm

Native to Madagascar

Native to mountainous rainforest New Calodonia Donated by Seabreeze Palms

P-25 Dictyosperma album Princess Palm, Hurricane Palm

Native to Mauritus, Mascarene Islands

P-26 Phoenix roebelenii

Pygmy Date Palm, Dwarf Date Palm

Native Assam to Vietnam

P-27 Arenga engleri Dwarf Sugar Palm, Formosa Palm

Native to Taiwan
P-28 Butia capitata

Pindo Palm, Jelly Palm, Wine Palm

Native to Brazil, Uruguay, Argentina

C-29 Cycas affinity circinalis (cycad) Fern Palm - Sago, Fern Cycas

Native to India, Madagascar, New Guinea, The Philippines

P-30 Syagrus schizophylla Arikuri Palm

Native to Brazil

P-31 Phoenix reclinata Senegal Date Palm

Native to Africa, Senegal to Napal

P-32 Phoenix rupicola (note: palm removed) Cliff Date Palm

Native to India

P-33 Dypsis decaryi (formerly Neodypsis decaryi) Triangle Palm, Three-Sided Palm

Native to South Madagascar

P-34 Rhapis excelsa

Rhapis Palm, Lady Palm, Bamboo Palm Native to South China

C-35 Zamia loddigesii (cycad)

Native to Chiapas, Mexico

P-36 Dypsis lutescens

Areca Palm, Golden Cane Palm, Butterfly Palm

Native to Madagascar

P-37 Cocos nucifera Coconut Palm, Maypan

Native probably to the Pacific Islands, but now distributed worldwide in the tropics Donated by Fort Myers - Lee County Garden Council in honor of Mrs. Howard L. Wheeler (Nancy)

P-38 Hyphaene thebaica African Doum Palm, Gingerbread Palm

Native to Egypt, West Coast of India Donated by Kelley's Landscaping

P-39 Hyophorbe lagenicaulis Bottle Palm

Native to Round Island (Mascarenes)

P-40 Adonidia merillii (formerly Veitchia merrillii) Adonidia, Christmas Palm, Manila Palm

Native to The Phillipines

P-41 Coccothrinax crinita Old Man Palm, Palma Petate

Native to Cuba

P-42 Corypha umbraculifera Talipot Palm

Native to Sri Lanka, South India

P-43 Areca catechu Betel Nut Palm

Native India through Southeast Asia, Malaysia & Pacific (exact origin uncertain)

C-44 Cycas revoluta (cycad) Sago Palm

Native South Japan to Java

P-45 Hyophorbe verschaffeltii Spindle Palm

Native to Rodrigues Island, Mascarenes Donated by Landings Realty, Inc.; O.J. Buigas, President

P-46 Ravenea rivularis Majesty Palm, Majestic Palm

Native to Madagascar Donated by Rick Hensley, Owl Hammock Nursery

P-47 Washingtonia robusta Washingtonian Palm, Skyduster, Mexican Fan Palm

Native to Northwest Mexico, Baja California
